



## **Summary of Questionnaire after LIS ALEPH500 Trainings**

**April 15 – 17, 2015.**

In April 15 – 17. 2015 were the trainings of the Acquisition + Serials, Cataloguing + MARC21 and Circulation modules. Trainings were held in the Demo version environment. Workshops were organized in 3 blocks. The trainers were Daiva Jurkšaitienė (LUHS Library), Sandra Ansberga (RTU Scientific Library), Sarmite Krauze (RTU Scientific Library). There were training materials about all modules and presentations. In the materials are the explanations of modules and real instructions and steps for activities in the GUI environment.

After trainings Questionnaire with 10 questions was spread. We received 16 Questionnaires with answers.

There was 16 respondents. Main groups are System administrators/librarians, cataloguers and deputy directors. All participants attended all lessons.

All respondents answered that explanation was clear, but two of participants the expected information received only partly.

The courses was very useful and trainings for the participants was very important and extremely important.

10 respondents answered that the training materials are extremely useful. I hope materials really will help to acquire the activities. One answer about materials is that training materials is partly useful. May be it is necessary to supplement the materials.

We can conclude that the organization of the courses were on high level. All participants were very satisfied with the trainings. In one form were two answers: very satisfied and partly satisfied.

For future plans to organizers and trainers very important are answers to last two questions.

Cataloging of different documents, analytic records, multi volume records, serials,

Authority files etc.,

Conversation.

What are the recommendations for next trainings?

Widespread suggestion is – more practical trainings in the real environment.
