# Networked communication




 The rise and spread of networked communication had a significant impact on the scholarly communication, as well.

The new models introduced to communication systems, to publications, and to publishing practices shared a common factor: they have become Internet mediated activities.

# Principles and Strategies for the Reform of Scholarly Communication

- The broadest possible access to published research and other scholarly writings;
- Increased control by scholars and the academy over the system of scholarly publishing,
- Fair and reasonable prices for scholarly information;
- Competitive markets for scholarly communication
- A diversified publishing industry;
- Open access to scholarship.

# OA: the practice of providing on-line access to scientific information that is free of charge to the end-user.




### Research infrastructure: definition

- ★ Research infrastructure means facilities, resources, and related services that are used by the scientific community to conduct top-level research in their respective fields and covers major scientific equipment or sets of instruments;
- \* knowledge-based resources such as collections, archives or structures for scientific information;
- enabling ICT-based infrastructures, or any other entity of a unique nature essential to achieve excellence in research.
- → Such infrastructures may be "single-sited" of distributed, that is an organized network of resources

# New Vision of Research Infrastructure in Europe

- European Strategy
   Forum on Research
   Infrastructures: ESFRI
- Role: to develop the scientific integration of all the partners of society;
- To act as an incubator for RI projects with pan-European interest



### **Horizon 2020**

- 'Science with and for Society' will be instrumental in addressing the European societal challenges tackled by Horizon 2020, building capacities and developing innovative ways of connecting science to society.
- It allows all societal actors (researchers, citizens, policy makers, business, etc.) to work together during the whole research and innovation process in order to better align both the process and its outcomes with the values, needs and expectations of European society.

# **EU Open Access Initiative**

Why Open Access?

Access to knowledge, information, and data is essential in higher education and research; and more generally, for sustained progress in society. Improved access is the basis for the transfer of knowledge, and knowledge valorisation.








## **Open AIRE pilot project**

- developing a joint policy and a statement on open access and putting it into action;
- supporting the necessary infrastructures for open access;
- promoting awareness of the importance of open access among researchers and administrators;
- initiating a dialogue with other national and European associations, publishers, and other non-European research organisations;
- to redefine the responsibilities and cost distribution of the publishing system;
- ensuring that permanent preservation and open access will be the rule for data repositories.



# **OpenAIRE** objectives

- to build support structures for researchers in depositing fp7funded research publications through the establishment of a European Helpdesk via 27 National Open Access Desks (noads);
- to establish and operate an electronic infrastructure for handling peer-reviewed articles as well as other important forms of publications.
- This is achieved through the Open AIRE portal that is the gateway to all user-level services offered, including access (search and browse) to scientific publications and other valueadded functionalities;
- To enchance the repository network by introducing rules for grant reporting in repositories.



- But not necessarily free!







### The Directory of Open Access Repositories - OpenDOAR

Search for repositories | Search repository contents | List of repositories | Repository Statistics

OpenDOAR is an authoritative directory of academic open access repositories. Each OpenDOAR repository has been visited by project staff to check the information that is recorded here. This in-depth approach does not rely on automated analysis and gives a quality-controlled list of repositories.

As well as providing a simple repository list, OpenDOAR lets you search for repositories or search repository contents. Additionally, we provide tools and support to both repository administrators and service providers in sharing best practice and improving the quality of the repository infrastructure. Further explanation of these features is given in a project document Beyond the list.

The current directory lists repositories and allows breakdown and selection by a variety of criteria see the Find page - which can also be viewed as statistical charts. The underlying database has been designed from the ground up to include in-depth information on each repository that can be used for search, analysis, or underpinning services like text-mining. The OpenDOAR service is being developed incrementally, developing the current service as new features are introduced. A list of Upgrades and Additions is available.

Developments will be of use both to users wishing to find original research papers and for service providers like search engines or alert services which need easy-to-use tools for developing tailored search services to suit specific user communities.






Growth of the OpenDOAR Dat




