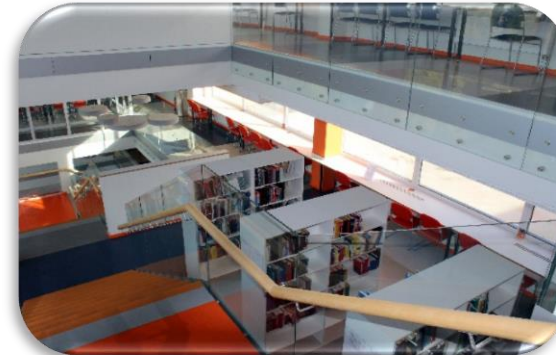
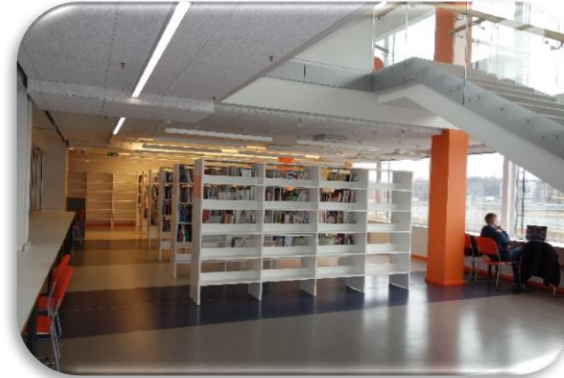

Subscribed Databases

Training for the library staff:

- Regular meetings, presentations, workshops, seminars in the library, conducted by the subscribed databases' suppliers
- Regular consultations and workshops, organized by Information and Technologies Department
- Webinars, organized by suppliers of the subscribed databases
- Guides and manuals (in English and Latvian)

- The subscribed and the trial access databases are available in the RTU network; authorization through IP addresses.
- Since academic year 2008 students and teaching staff of the RTU can access these databases also outside the University, 24/7, through RTU portal “Ortus” <http://www.ortus.rtu.lv>.

DEDICATE Project

- In 1998-1999 library was involved in the EU funded project **DEDICATE** (Distance EDucation Information Courses with Access Through nEtworks) in cooperation with libraries of Sweden, Finland, UK, Latvia, Hungary, Poland, Estonia, Lithuania
- The aim of the DEDICATE project was to develop distance education courses in information literacy.
- The librarians of RTU Scientific Library together with the Faculty of Material Science and Applied Chemistry and Faculty of Electronics and Telecommunications staff elaborated

Information Literacy in RTU Scientific Library

- Library offers Information Literacy courses, including lectures and practical workshops, online courses
- Information Literacy courses are designed to meet the requirements of the following groups:
 - New students
 - Undergraduates and Postgraduates
 - Academic staff

Information Literacy in RTU Scientific Library

Lecture “Introduction to the Library” for the 1st year students:

- Since 2000
- Every year in September
- Duration: 30min.-1hour 30 min.
- Content: library homepage, structure of the library, holdings, opening hours, library services, regulations, catalogues, searching, access to subscribed and trial online databases

The students must attend this lecture, but they do not receive credit points for this lecture.

Only students of Riga Stradins university get credit points for the information literacy.

Information Literacy in RTU Scientific Library

For undergraduates and postgraduates:

- Practical workshops of the usage of electronic resources for the 2nd-3rd year students of Materials Science and Applied Chemistry Faculty (since 2000)
The workshop is a part of the courses of “Chemistry Informatics” and of “Information Literacy”.

The students must attend this workshop

- Lecture and practical workshop of the usage of electronic resources for the 3rd year students and postgraduates of Power and Electrical Engineering Faculty (since 2006)
- Practical workshops for the students and postgraduates of other faculties on request
- Meetings and seminars, organized by suppliers of the subscribed databases

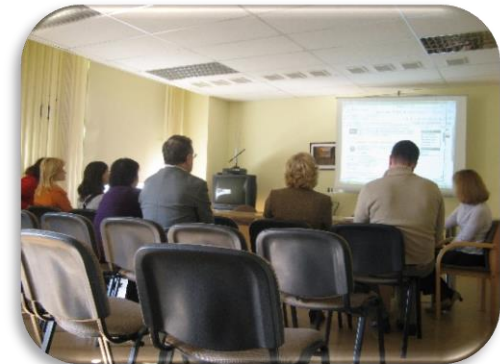
Information Literacy in RTU Scientific Library

For RTU Academic staff:

- Practical workshops (OPAC, Searching in subscribed and trial access databases, Consultations on data input in RTU [Scientific Publications database "SCIENCE"](#))
- Face to face consultations on request
- Consultations by telephone, simultaneous searching
- Meetings and seminars organized by suppliers of the subscribed databases

The Library offers individual and group training in information searching in the electronic catalogue, databases and e-resources

Training for Moldova librarians

- 9 – 16 of March, 2016 training in Iuliu Hațieganu University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Cluj-Napoca, Romania;
