- **Report of the project activities during year 2015.** Liubovi Karnaeva, MD, Meilė Kretavičienė, LT
 - The leader of the WP2 group Dr. Márta Virágos apologizes, because she couldn't come to the meeting on 27 January, 2016 in Chisinau
 - Liubovi Karnaeva presented Moldovan Universities' activities, current situation of the project, project report 2015. Presentation is available in the project website http://misisq.usmf.md/images/meeting_27-27_ianuarie_2016/raport_meeting_ianuarie_2016.pdf (Annex 1)

Liubovi Karnaeva: Our Project is difficult, because we have to implement two WP in one time. WP2 is already implemented in all 7 MD Universities, but it is necessary to improve it all the time. V.Lupu is responsible for WP2 in MD. A lot of meetings and discussions were held between MD partners for WP2. Repository team – manager, system administrator, metadata specialist/cataloguer was created. DSpace was implemented. WP2 documentation Kit (OA Policy, Rules of organization and operation of IR, authors' declaration, Guide of Archiving publications in IR) was prepared. Conference dedicated to e-repository was organized in MD. Regarding WP1, groups according modules were created in every library. A lot of trainings were organized in MD. LV partners helped us. We do conversion now. We have questions, but ExLibris answer very slowly.

Regarding dissemination, all information is placed in our web site. Promotional materials are produced. Many presentations are presented in the meetings and conferences and articles are published in the local newspapers for the project dissemination. It is available in our project website. MD partners are ready to register repository.

Elena Harconita: What about Card catalogue? It is necessary for our university.

Meilė Kretavičienė: You don't need it. LUHS do not use it.

Aija Janbicka: RTU do not use it too.

Daiva Jurkšaitienė: There is such possibility, engineer can create it, but Card catalogue is not useful.

Silvia Ginculova: We try not to use Card catalogue.

Meilė Kretavičienė: Do you produce copies?

Liubovi Karnaeva: Yes.

Meilė Kretavičienė: We strongly recommend not using Card catalogue.

Liubovi Karnaeva: We want to have main data in the Card catalogue.

Meilė Kretavičienė: Do you do cataloguing?

Liubovi Karnaeva: No. We wait ExLibris. We can start Circulation.

Daiva Jurkšaitienė: You must start Cataloguing. It is good time for testing.

Meilė Kretavičienė: Do you work with Primo?

Liubovi Karnaeva: Yes, but do not use it.

Daiva Jurkšaitienė: There is possibility to include database.

Meilė Kretavičienė: You need to install DSpace in to Primo.

Elena Harconita: Who will teach us how to install database?

Daiva Jurkšaitienė: It is necessary one person responsible for it, who needs to study special information (instructions).

Silvia Ginculova: We need to collaborate between MD partners.

Meilė Kretavičienė: You need to work within consortia of MD partners.

Daiva Jurkšaitienė: I suggest making a decision when to start using Aleph and Primo and permanent address for Aleph and Primo.

Liubovi Karnaeva: We need more training.

Meilė Kretavičienė: There is possibility for you can come to LUHS for training.

- Meilė Kretavičienė presented project activities during 2015, project report and Statement of the costs incurred submitted to EACEA on December 9, 2015.

- **Tempus Agency Monitoring Report.** Meilė Kretavičienė, LT

- Meilė Kretavičienė presented Tempus Agency Monitoring Report, the main recommendations which should be taken into consideration during the project implementation.

Meilė Kretavičienė: Mrs. Virginia Revenco, Coordinator of the National Erasmus+ Office (NEO) in Moldova, carried out a field monitoring visit of the project at the University of medicine and Pharmacy "N. Testemitanu", on 26.10.2015.

A strong dissemination and sustainability plan is needed to ensure a broader visibility of the project and a full use of the software.

All involved universities should place the link to the E-repository on the University and/or Library webpages which are definitely more visited by the students and teachers rather than the project website. Liubovi Karnaeva informed that it is done.

The project team should make a glossary of library terms (E-repository, LIS, Policy for Open Access Data, Information literacy, etc.) used in the project in order "to popularise" the notions among the potential beneficiaries. This Glossary should be uploaded on the Library and/or project webpages.

The universities involved should follow that their Library is visible on the institutional webpage. There is no easy access to the Library webpages when navigating the University webpages.

The local team should conduct as soon as possible an assessment of information literacy among students in cooperation with the National Council of Student Organizations from Moldova. Liubovi Karnaeva informed that it is done.

The project team should conceive a concrete sustainability strategy in order to ensure that the E-repository and the LIS will be exploited by the universities after the project ends, by extending their network and involving other universities outside the Consortium. The team could envisage to develop a new project in KA2 Erasmus+ in this respect.

The project team should strive to register their institutional repositories in the international registry for open access data, such as ROAR, DOAR, DRIVER, for a better visibility internationally. Liubovi Karnaeva informed that it is done.

- **WP3: Information literacy, Ioana Robu (RO)**
 - Ioana Robu presented work plan for WP3 Information literacy (Annex 2), questionnaire for course participants and feedback review, general considerations, preparation and proposal of the training schedule (program) (Annex 3). Presentation is available in the project website http://misisq.usmf.md/images/meeting_27-27_ianuarie_2016/WP3-presentation.pdf (Annex 4). The courses must be organized up to the end of March, according to the project plan. The evaluation and review of course materials should be also done by EU partner. Ioana suggested to this for her Romanian colleagues, because the course material is in Romanian.
- **Discussion on the project documentation management**
 - Meilė Kretavičienė and Lijana Lunskutė presented practical information on the project Staff Costs Co-financing requirements.
 - Lijana Lunskutė consulted regarding Financial Statement and other project documents.
- **Discussion on WP1, WP2 results & quality assurance**
 - Viorica Lupu presented all Moldovan partners' project situation for WP2. Presentation is available in the project website http://misisq.usmf.md/images/Meeting_MD/DSpaceReport.pdf (Annex 5).

1. selection of persons from each libraries to be responsible for IR building (repository manager who manages all aspects of IR implementation – advocacy, communication, policies, internal and external liasons, repository administrator who manages the technical and software implementation and metadata specialist /cataloguer who manages metadata, describes items);

2. defining roles and responsibilities within Dspace, authorisations, rights and privileges.

3. Trainings:

- a. Library and the Information Centre of Lithuanian University of Health Sciences (Kaunas, LT)
- b. Life Sciences Library, University of Debrecen

Legal considerations

- Discussions between the university administration and repository manager about regulations, norms and other repository building aspects;
- Meetings with university communities and authors on document deposit in the institutional repository, benefits of IR, respect for copyright, authorizations to make the contents public etc.;
- Presentations about IR building by library directors at the Administrative Council of universities

Documentation

- Establishment of necessary documents drawn up to regulate e-repository:
 - Institutional policy on open access
 - Rules of organization and operation of IR;
 - Agreements / contracts regarding copyright etc.
- Development of repository release form to obtain permissions from authors to ensure open access for their materials in the repository

WP3 –Information Literacy Working Plan

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION AND DELIVERY OF THE COURSE –

ACTIVITIES IN THE “TRAIN THE TRAINERS” COMPONENT

The main objective of this activity is to increase the Moldovan librarians' skills and abilities in developing information literacy programs for the academic communities which they serve and be active trainers in these programs.

To fulfill this objective the courses for the Moldovan librarians will include current topics and subjects, as outlined in the proposed schedule.

The content of each course module should essentially include 3 parts: (1) theoretical, (2) practical, (3) feedback.

- 1) The theoretical part could be comprised of a brief introduction of the topic or subject, an argument regarding why its mastering is important for the academic community, followed by the actual presentation – principles, structure, use etc.
- 2) The practical part could include one or more guided exercises performed by the course leader, followed by hands-on exercises performed by the participants – the first exercise is proposed by the course leader, then others may be chosen at the participants' suggestion.
- 3) Feedback might simply consist in a final discussion session with the participants regarding the course subject: how they think they learned it, difficulties or problems, aspects not enough emphasized, how they think they will in their turn teach on the subject etc.

The balance between the 3 parts depends on the topic taught, some topics require more or less theory or practice.

The format of the courses should obviously have a visual component, e.g. PowerPoint presentation, HTML or even Word, clearly written and attractive, with illustrations if possible, screen shots, videos, or any combinations of these, well adapted to the content delivered.

The language will be Romanian (Moldovan) or Russian, both being well understood and spoken by the Moldovan librarians.

There will be two participant groups (~15 in a group), courses being delivered consecutively to the groups (3 days for each group).

The courses venue is the student branch library of the Iuliu Hatieganu University of Medicine and Pharmacy of Cluj-Napoca, Romania, equipped with individual work stations and presentation facilities.

DEFINITION OF INFORMATION LITERACY

A broad conception defines information literacy in terms of ***a set of competencies that an informed citizen of an information society ought to possess to participate intelligently and actively in that society*** (AASL: "Information power...", 1988).

The American Library Association's (ALA) Presidential Committee on Information Literacy, Final Report states that, "***To be information literate, a person must be able to recognize when information is needed and have the ability to locate, evaluate, and use effectively the needed information***" (1989).





In 2000 the ACRL (Association of College and Research Libraries) established *Information Literacy Competency Standards for Higher Education*:

"Information literacy forms the basis for lifelong learning. It is common to all disciplines, to all learning environments, and to all levels of education. It enables learners to master content and extend their investigations, become more self-directed, and assume greater control over their own learning".



An information literate individual is able to:

- *Determine the extent of information needed;*
- *Access the needed information effectively and efficiently;*
- *Evaluate information and its sources critically;*
- *Incorporate selected information into one's knowledge base;*
- *Use information effectively to accomplish a specific purpose;*
- *Understand the economic, legal, and social issues surrounding the use of information, and access and use information ethically and legally.*



Europe & Information Literacy

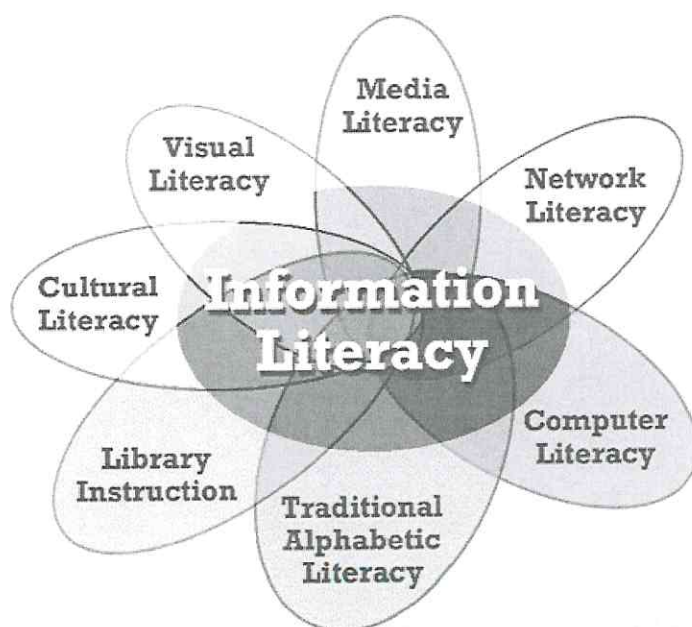
In European countries the information-literacy movement has evolved from precursors such as library instruction, bibliographic instruction and user/reader education.

In 2000 the European Commission's draft document A *Memorandum on Lifelong Learning* using the term "digital literacy" appeared. It launched a European-wide debate for a comprehensive strategy to implement lifelong learning.

Information literacy is a pervading component of the biggest EU Research and Innovation program – **Horizon 2020**

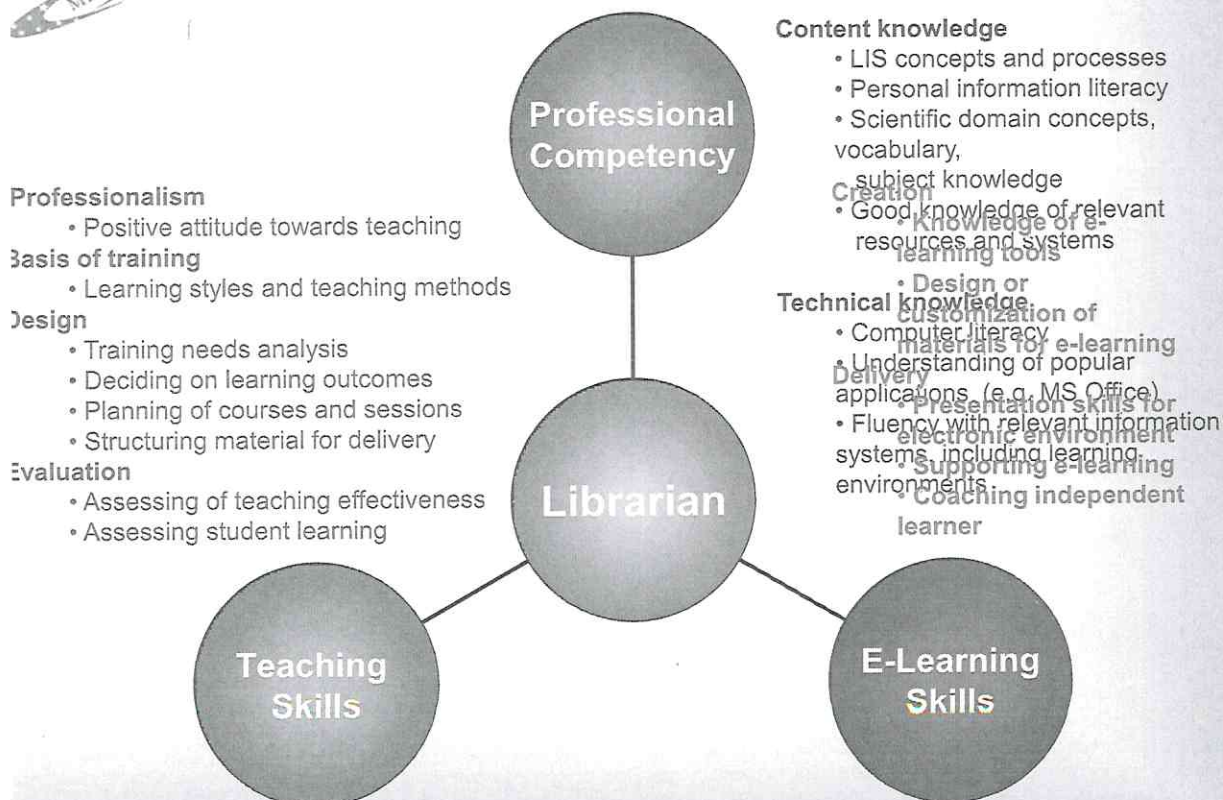
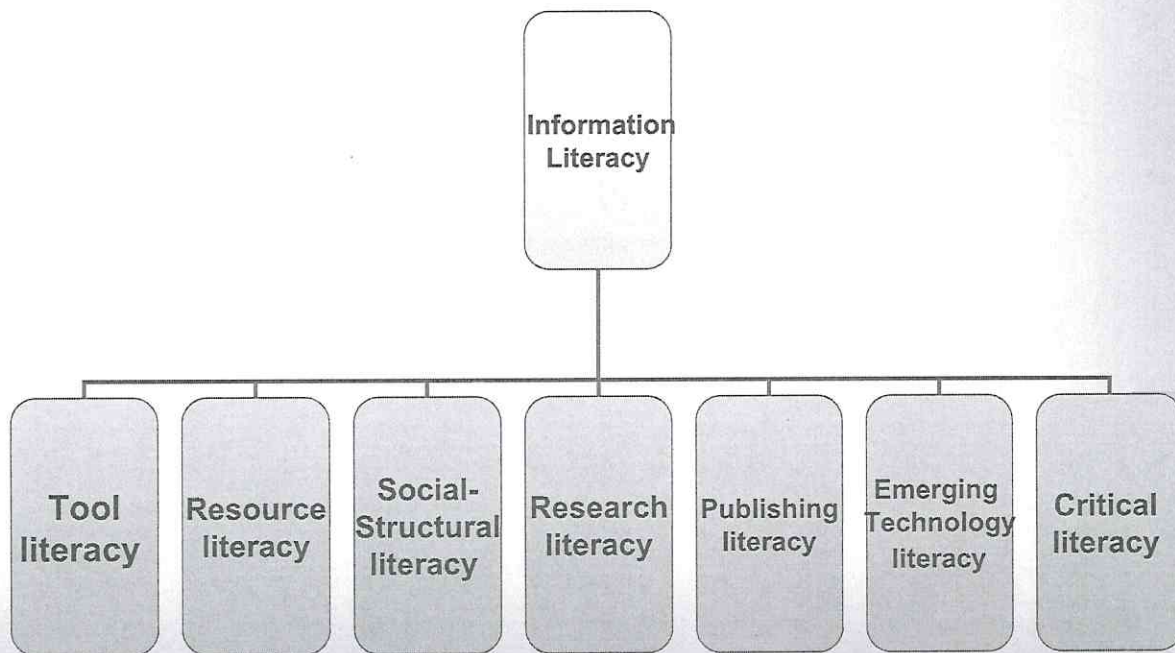

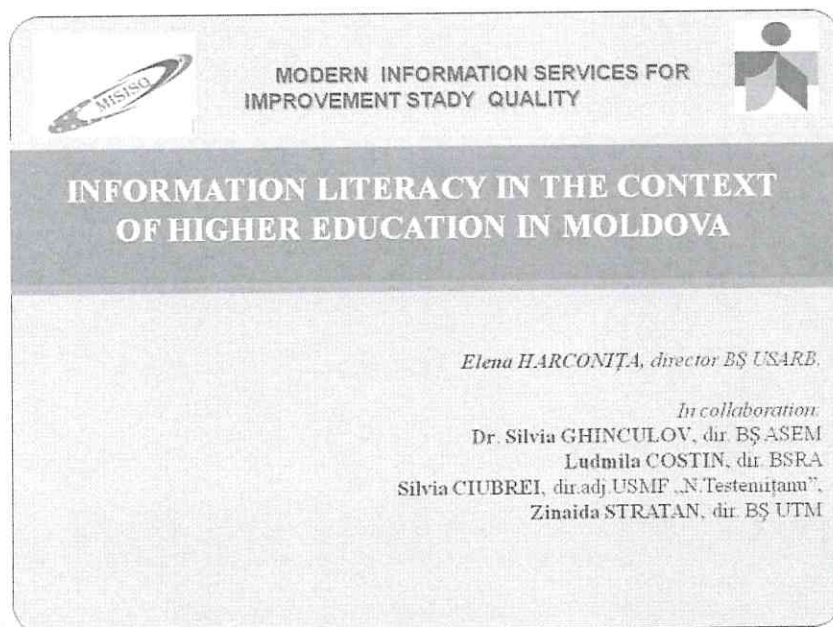

Experience of Moldovan Academic libraries

ASEM – Academia de Studii Economice

- *started training courses as early as 1992*
- *implemented training programs for 1st year 2005 – 2012*
- *project with the University of Bergen 2012-2014*
- *developed Information Literacy Curricula at undergraduate, Master and Doctoral levels (see document)*



Experience of Moldovan Academic libraries

USMF “Nicolae Testemiteanu” Library

- *Info Lit. program for 1st year students 2009-2011 – 30 academic hours*
- *for Master level 2005 -2009*

U. Stiintifica “Alecu Russo” Balti

- *experience with courses since 1970’*
- *since 2003 the course “Basis of Information Culture” has been included in the curriculum as extension of the Informatics course- 30 hours/year*
- *2007 it became a separate module – a textbook “The Basis of Information Literacy” was drafted .*

Project stipulations

"Education courses will be delivered to librarians who are/will be responsible for user training and providing with information services. There will be trained 30 University librarians in 2 groups, each group ~32 acad.hrs. "

"Course material for 4 training modules will be prepared (for 2 academic hrs. each) on currently hot topics: modern information technologies & scholar communication, information resources & searching strategy, management of information resources & citing scientific articles, and 3-4 modules on subject information resources. Course material consists of theory, practical exercises, web version and PPT."



Project stipulations (continued)

- **LUHS** will be responsible for WP coordination and management and also for peer reviewing of course materials. LUHS will prepare 1 module of education material and will deliver courses for trainers.
- **SUMPh** will be responsible for coordination of Moldova partners, preparing analysis/study on information literacy in Moldova universities, organizing education courses and user training.
- **MSU** staff will contribute in preparing information literacy analysis, preparing questionnaire for survey. User training, preparing analysis/study about information literacy in Moldova universities.
- **TUM** will contribute to preparing analysis/study about information literacy in Moldova universities, and user training. Will contribute to preparing course material on Technical Science information resources.



Project stipulations (continued)

- **ASEM** - Will contribute to preparing analysis/study of information literacy in Moldova universities, and user training. Will contribute in preparing course material on economic information resources.
- **USB** Will contribute to preparing analysis/study on information literacy in Moldova universities, and user training.
- **UPS "I.Creanga"** will contribute preparing analysis/study on information literacy in Moldova universities, and User training. Will contribute to preparing course material on Social Science information resources.
- **SAUM** - Will contribute to preparing analysis/study about information literacy in Moldova universities, and User training. Will contribute in preparing course material on Agriculture Science information resources.



Project stipulations (continued)

- **RTU** will be responsible for preparing 1 module of education material on information literacy and will give courses for trainees. Will contribute in preparing course material on Technical and Social Sciences information resources.
- **UNIDEB** will be responsible for preparing course materials in interactive form and publishing on the WEB, and preparing 1 module of education material, delivering courses for trainers. UNIDEB will peer review course

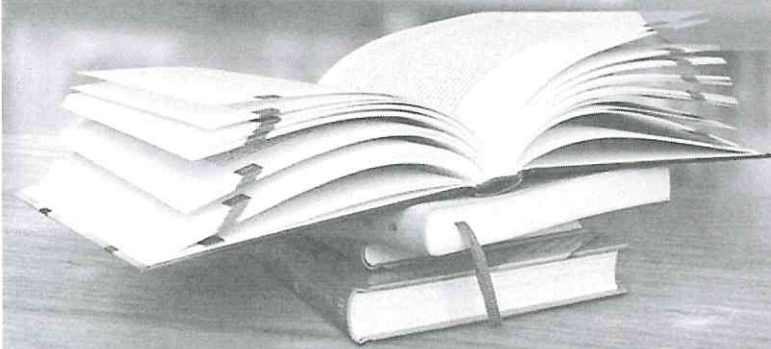
